4. Contributed to equal opportunity for the selection, promotion or retention of women and minorities in senior ranking positions and under-represented occupations.

5. Created opportunities that support and contribute to the mentorship, development, advancement, or retention of all personnel, including women and minorities, in government service consistent with merit-based principles.
