The theme for this year is "Unite Our Voices by Speaking Together". The NLTP is held to coincide with the observance of Asian Pacific Islander Heritage Month. It is the largest conference of its kind. Through your participation as well as sponsorship you can reach out to not only Asian American and Pacific Islanders (AAPI) but to all federal employees throughout the Federal government.

The National Leadership Training Program is expected to draw 200-300 attendees across the federal and DC governments to learn from the experiences of senior government officials and workshops on career development, leadership, strategic management, communications and diversity. We will also have programs for veterans and students that are attending free for special segments of the NLTP and can visit the exhibitors.

The NLTP has been approved by the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) every year as an appropriate training for federal workforce. In addition to the plenary sessions, the NLTP is a great opportunity for professional and personal development through the many workshops in communications, career development, leadership and diversity in the workplace presented by experienced and dynamic trainers. There are workshops for young professionals and healthcare issues relating to AAPI. Over 50 agencies will have exhibits with information on their career programs and job opportunities for students and veterans. Exhibits will be open from Tuesday May 16 through Thursday May 18. FAPAC continue to provide its Executive Career Coaching to attendees; participant can meet one-on-one and face-to-face with an executive coach for consultation and career advice.

FAPAC recognizes civilian and military employees and partnered with the Department of Defense (DoD) and other agencies on the recognition and honoring of our military, and civilian employees; these recognitions and awards are presented during the award luncheons and evening banquet as part of the program. In addition, FAPAC will be presenting a scholarship award, funded entirely from the proceeds of support to our NLTP. The Scholarship winner is chosen from submissions of students from across the country and is presented to the worthy recipient who plans a career in public service.
